Dr. Henry C. Lee is one of the world's foremost forensic scientists. Dr. Lee's work has made him a landmark in modern-day criminal investigations. In practice, forensic science draws upon the principles and methods of all the traditional sciences, such as physics, chemistry, biology, and mathematics. The term forensic science is sometimes used as a synonym for criminalistics.
